Winners of this award agree to:

- * Present your accepted paper to the conference.
- * Attend at least 50% of the conference sessions.
- * Attend the annual IALJS business meeting held during the conference.
- * Within 15 days of the end of the conference, submit a 350-word report saying the sessions you attended and some thoughts on what you learned. Note: we may publish this report in the IALJS Newsletter.

All applicants will be notified as soon as possible after the conference program is released as to whether they were or were not successful. Successful applicants will be presented with a certificate at the business meeting held during the conference. They will receive the award funds at or immediately after the conference.
